1. On March 17, 2009, the Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) No. R1-2009-0031 for PEPSI-COLA of Eureka located in Eureka, California (Site). MRP Order No. R1-2009-0031 contained monitoring and reporting requirements for surface water quality and petroleum hydrocarbon contaminant trends. This MRP was used for verification monitoring following implementation of remedial actions to address petroleum hydrocarbon contamination at the Site.
2. The Pepsi Bottling Group completed monitoring and reporting activities thereby fully complying with MRP Order No. R1-2009-0130.
3. The overall effectiveness of the remedial actions is supported by the verification monitoring data. Hence, successful completion of economically reasonable and technologically feasible remedial actions occurred at the Site.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2009-0031 is rescinded.
