Rescission of Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 91-81

1. On May 10, 1991, Benjamin D. Kor, Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) No. 91-81 for the site located at 2145 Mendocino Avenue in Santa Rosa. MRP Order No. 91-81 contained requirements for groundwater monitoring, sampling and reporting using monitoring wells installed at the site.
2. Remedial investigation and cleanup work was performed at the site. On October 27, 2011, Regional Water Board staff concurred that no further action was required. Site monitoring wells were destroyed. As a result, MRP No. 91-81 is no longer applicable to current site conditions. Based on the available information, it is appropriate to rescind MRP No. 91-81.

Therefore, it is hereby ordered that Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 91-81 is rescinded.
