Attached is the letter we faxed to your office on May 19, 2011. Mr. Barcellos pumped out several thousand gallons from the large tank several months ago. He also took the three smaller tanks out of service. The large tank is now continuously operating at a much lower liquid level. He dug a trench to expose one side of the large tank to determine if any seepage was occurring after he pumped liquid from the tank. We have not seen any seepage since he pumped the tank several months ago.

Our consultants inspected the Trinity Dam Mobile Home Park on May 24, 2011 by viewing the property and taking several water samples. Our consultants included a Civil Engineer and a Geologist. The water sample results were all within acceptable limits. As we discussed, we will continue to work with you to accomplish the mutual goal of satisfying the Water Quality Control Board.

Jody Burgess will be handling the Water Quality Control Board issue from this point forward. Naturally, I will provide the information in my possession to Mr. Burgess to assist him. Jody can be reached at
