RESCISSION OF CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT
ORDER NO. 88-47

1. On March 22, 1988 the Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 88-47 (CAO 88-47) to Kayo Oil Company (Discharger) for the facility located at 7898 Old Redwood Highway in Cotati, California (Site). CAO 88-47 required the Discharger to investigate and cleanup the Site from the release of petroleum hydrocarbons to soil and groundwater.
2. In 1986 the single walled petroleum underground storage tanks (USTs) were removed and replaced with double-walled fiberglass tanks. Multiple soil and groundwater cleanup actions have been used to remediate both soil and groundwater impacts related to petroleum release at this Site. These actions include: excavation of impacted soils to the extent possible, soil vapor extraction, air sparging, groundwater extraction, and ozone sparging.
3. The site investigation and remediation is complete and the Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a No Further Action Required letter on October 28, 2013. The Discharger has complied with CAO 88-47 and the Order is no longer needed.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 88-47 is rescinded.
