RESCISSION OF CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT AND 13267 ORDER NO. R1-2011-0021

1. On January 28, 2011, the Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Cleanup and Abatement and 13267 Order No. R1-2011-0021 (CAO) to Eric Windschitl (Discharger) for the site located at 1520 USFS Road N09, near Burnt Ranch, in Trinity County. The CAO required the Discharger to correct violations associated with unauthorized construction of roads and earthen pads, and modification of watercourses through instream dam construction on the subject property. Corrective work undertaken to address the violation included removal or stabilization of earthen pads, road stabilization and drainage improvements, dam removal, stream channel restoration, and re-vegetation of disturbed areas affected by the illegal work.
2. On July 31, 2012, Regional Water Board staff inspected the site and confirmed that water quality violations had been adequately corrected, and that the requirements of the CAO had been satisfactorily completed. Required monitoring reports provided subsequent to work completion indicate that the site has remained stable and the restoration work has been effective. Based on the available information, it is appropriate to rescind CAO No. R1-2011-0021.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that CAO No. R1-2011-0021 is rescinded.
