1. On April 18, 1996, the Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 97-45 (CAO No. 97-45) to Unocal Corporation, James A. Gaddis and Barbara M. Gaddis, Gaddis Nursery, Inc., California Homes, Inc., Joseph P. Murphy Corporation and Cooper, Towery and Murphy Partnership for the Gaddis Nursery site located at 1051 Spencer Avenue in Santa Rosa, California. CAO No. 97-45 required the Dischargers to investigate and clean up a release of petroleum hydrocarbons to soil and groundwater.

2. Site investigation and remediation are complete. The Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a No Further Action Required letter on December 19, 2013. The Dischargers complied with CAO No. 97-45 and the Order is no longer needed.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 97-45 is rescinded.
