MONITORING

1. The depth to groundwater in each monitoring well shall be determined to at least 0.01 foot increments semiannually. The results of each month's elevation shall be reported in tabular form indicating the surveyed elevations of each well reference point, depth to groundwater from reference point, and the actual groundwater elevation. The data generated from the elevation readings must be referenced to mean sea level.
2. Monitoring wells MW-4 and MW-5 shall be sampled semiannually. The surface water drainage ditch at the south of the property will be sampled quarterly at 30 feet below the historical discharge area. The analyses shall be performed at a certified laboratory for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylene, and methyl tert butyl ether (MtBE).

REPORTING

Semiannual monitoring reports, including semiannual groundwater elevation data and quarterly and semiannual sampling date, shall be submitted to this office in accordance with the following schedule:
