This stipulation for entry of judgment (Stipulated Judgment) was arrived at through Regional Water Board representation by the California Attorney General's Office and negotiation with the parties. The proposed judgment gives the Regional Water Board the assurance that the remaining work required by Cleanup and Abatement Order R1-2011-0014 (Order) will be completed and provides a monetary liability in the amount of \$25,000.

This agreement represents the final negotiated agreement between Thomas Rider Plowright III, Patricia Plowright (Defendants) and the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board. Pursuant to the State Water Quality Control Board's Enforcement Policy it cannot be considered final until a 30-day public comment period is complete.

Public comment will be received until June 15, 2015. Comments may be submitted by email addressed to Stormer.Feiler@waterboards.ca.gov. Once the public comment period is complete, provided there are no comments or changes, the final stipulated agreement will be signed by all parties and filed in Mendocino County Superior Court as an enforceable final judgment.
