This Amended Order by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Water Board), is being issued pursuant to the California Water Code Sections 13260 and 13269, and amends the *Applicability of General Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements, Resolution 87-113, for the Western Gardens Subdivision project, Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, August 19, 2002*. This amendment was necessary to update the ownership of the property, which has been sold by Mr. Ron Aloise, to Mr. Sam Biasi of DAS Homes Inc., and to extend the expiration date of the Order. This Amended Order is in response to a request from Mr. Sam Biasi of DAS Homes Inc., dated April 10, 2006, to transfer the above-referenced Order from Mr. Ron Aloise to its successor-in-interest, Mr. Sam Biasi and DAS Homes Inc..

The terms and conditions of the Order dated August 19, 2002 remain in full affect and Mr. Sam Biasi and DAS Homes Inc. will now be responsible for full implementation of those terms and conditions (Enclosure 1 - *Applicability of General Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements, Resolution 87-113, for the Western Gardens Subdivision project, Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, August 19, 2002*).

**Expiration:** The authorization of this Order for any dredge and fill activities expires on October 16, 2010. Conditions and monitoring requirements outlined in this certification are not subject to the expiration date outlined above, and remain in full effect and are enforceable.
