On August 29, 2013, Mr. Henry Alden Submitted the annual mining plan for the subject site, for gravel extraction from the Gualala River for the 2013 season. Additional information was received, and the fee of \$1,800 for the currently proposed extraction volume of 12,000 cubic yards of aggregate was received on October 7, 2013. The proposed plan is for aggregate to be extracted on three gravel bars (Bars 62, 70 and 295). If the applicant is interested in extracting gravel from additional bars another mining plan must be submitted, the appropriate fee paid, and another Notice of Approval letter will be issued by the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board. Total extraction is limited to 40,000 cubic yards per year, not to exceed 133,200 cubic yards over the five year term of the current 401 Water Quality Certification. This Notice of Approval amends the current 401 Water Quality Certification to include the extraction as described above and within the materials submitted to the application.
