On March 10, 2011, Mr. Tom Lauderbach of Burbank Housing Development Corporation (Applicant) submitted a Request for an Amendment to the existing Clean Water Act Section 401 Certification (Water Quality Certification) Order and Amendment for the Burbank Housing – Catalina Townhomes and Amorosa Village (project), formerly know as Dutton Meadows Phase V, Dutton Village Project. This request is the third amendment to the Water Quality Certification. This amendment request is based on the requirement to provide LID stormwater treatment for addition of newly created impervious areas. The project is required by the City of Santa Rosa to improve off-site roads. The improvements to these roads were not included in the original Water Quality Certification application. There is not room to create LID treatments on the new road; consequently the Applicant is creating LID treatments at an existing Burbank Housing site at 2860, 2862 and 2870 Apple Valley Lane, in Santa Rosa.
