Subject: Notice of Applicability (NOA) for Coverage under the State Water Resources Control Water Quality Order 2004-0004-DWQ for Dredged or Fill Discharges to Waters Deemed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to be Outside of Federal Jurisdiction

On September 9, 2014, the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) received a Notice of Intent (NOI) to comply with the terms of, and obtain coverage under, the State Water Resources Control Water Quality Order 2004-0004-DWQ for Dredged or Fill Discharges to Waters Deemed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to be Outside of Federal Jurisdiction (General WDR) for the Redwood Marine Terminal Project (project) from Mr. Kevin Mckenny of Redwood Marine (applicant).

The project is located in the Eureka Plain Hydrologic Unit (110.00) at 1210 and 1240 Broadway, Eureka, CA. The scope of the project is to restore 2,900 square feet or 0.066 acres of wetland and riparian habitat at the project site. The project will involve excavating a 2,900 square foot area approximately four feet deep, placing approximately two to three feet of topsoil loam in this area, and planting wetland and riparian vegetation. The restoration will be conducted in accordance with the *Wetland Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan, Revision 1*, prepared for Reg Crossan by SHN Consulting Engineers & Geologists, Inc. dated August 2014.

Work would occur during the fall of 2014, with a work period up to October 15, 2014.

Regional Water Board staff has determined that the project, as described in the NOI, is categorically exempt from CEQA review (section 15333 Small Habitat Restoration Projects). The applicant has verified that a Clean Water Act, section 404 authorization from the United States Army Corps of Engineers is not required.

The project shall be constructed and maintained as described within application materials.
