On December 31, 2014, we received your letter requesting an amendment to the August 7, 2007, Federal Clean Water Act, section 401, Water Quality Certification (certification) for the Vast Oak Properties Project.

In response to your request, this letter serves as an amendment to Condition 21, allowing an extension of the authorization of this certification as outlined below:

Condition 21: The authorization of this Order for any dredge and fill activities expires on December 31, 2019. To the extent the conditions and monitoring requirements required by this Order extend beyond December 31, 2019, they do not expire and remain in effect and are enforceable.

I hereby issue an amendment to the expiration date in Condition 21 of the Certification for the Vast Oak Properties Project (WDID 1B03040WNSO) certifying that the remainder of the Water Quality Certification sections of the August 7, 2007, Order are still valid.
