On September 8, 2016, the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (North Coast Water Board) received your request to amend the June 14, 2016, Notice of Applicability (NOA) for Coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board General 401 Water Quality Certification for Small Habitat Restoration Projects (General 401 Order) SB12006GN for the Live Oaks Ranch Bridge Replacement Project (project).

In response to your request, this letter serves as an amendment to the approved project description proposed in the Notice of Intent (NOI), allowing a modification of the expected completion date of the project as outlined below:

Project Time Frame

Proposed project start date: August 15, 2016
Expected date of completion: October 15, 2017
Estimated work window: 45 days

Note: This certification authorizes project related activities and discharges for up to five years. If the applicant is unable to complete the project in 2017, they shall notify the Regional Water Board in writing of the proposed implementation time frame prior to subsequent seasonal work windows.

I hereby issue an amendment to the project description of the NOA for the Live Oaks Ranch Bridge Replacement Project (WDID 1B16573WNSO) certifying that the remainder of the Water Quality Certification sections of the June 14, 2021 Order are still valid.
