SUBJECT: **Public Hearing** on Order No. R1-2012-0028, to Consider Rescinding Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2008-0099, and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2010-0091, for **Chevron Environmental Management Company, Former Redwood Oil Chevron Bulk Plant**, Sonoma County

#### DISCUSSION

Order No. R1-2012-0028 is to rescind the Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2008-0099 and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) R1-2010-0091. On October 23, 2008, the Regional Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2008-0099 requiring Chevron Environmental Management Company to comply with discharge prohibitions, specifications, and provisions for the application of surfactant to the subsurface at the facility in Santa Rosa, California. Order No. R1-2008-0099 also requires compliance with Contingency Planning and Notification Requirements Order No. 74-151 and MRP No. R1-2008-0099. MRP No. R1-2008-0099 was replaced on October 7, 2010 by MRP No. R1-2010-0091.

Surfactant activities conducted in accordance with Order No. R1-2008-0099 were reported in the July 28, 2011 *Surfactant Enhanced Recovery Report*. Findings presented include recommendations to discontinue the use of surfactant and evaluate additional alternatives for free product removal. Regional Water Board staff concurred with these recommendations in a letter dated October 26, 2011. Surfactant activities conducted under Order No. R1-2008-0099 have ceased and Order No. R1-2008-0099 and MRP No. R1-2010-0091 should be rescinded.
