On the basis of preliminary staff review and application of lawful standards and regulations, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, proposes to adopt Waste Discharge Requirements for the Trinity County Closure of Weaverville Class III Solid Waste Disposal Site and Operation of Weaverville Inert Cell Solid Waste Disposal Site.

A public meeting to consider comments and objections to the proposed Order is scheduled for June 18, 2015, in Santa Rosa at 8:30 a.m. or as mentioned in the Regional Water Board's agenda to be mailed about June 3, 2015. The meeting will be held in the North Coast Regional Water Board Hearing Room, located at 5550 Skylane Boulevard, Suite A in Santa Rosa.

Interested persons must submit to the Regional Water Board office at 5550 Skylane Boulevard, Suite A, Santa Rosa, California, 95403, written copies of all technical reports, testimony, and other evidentiary material concerning this issued by 5:00 p.m. on May 4, 2015. This written material will be submitted to the Regional Water board members and all interested persons along with the full agenda materials.

Written material received after the above date will not be accepted except at the discretion of the Regional Water Board chair. Untimely written material will not be accepted or incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice the Dischargers or the Regional Water Board staff. The Chair may choose to modify this rule upon a showing of severe hardship (California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Sections 648.1 and 648.4).

All those who plan to testify at the hearing must submit written statements to the Regional Water Quality Control Board by June 11, 2015. Testimony at the above-scheduled hearing should be limited to a summary of the above-described written evidence. The time constraints for oral testimony or comments will be set by Regional Water Board Chair and usually will allow no more than ten minutes for the Regional Water Board staff and the Discharger and three minutes for other interested persons. A timer may be used and speakers are expected to honor the time limits. Where speakers can be grouped by affiliation or interest, such groups will be expected to select a spokesperson and not be repetitive.

The tentative Order, related documents and comments received are on file at the Regional Water Board office (5550 Skylane Boulevard, Suite A, Santa Rosa, California). These materials may be inspected or copied at the Regional Water Board office Mondays through

Fridays from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 a.m. Appointments are recommended for file review and can be made by calling (707) 576-2220.
