Notice of Corrective Action Plan Approval:
Comment Period Ends May 13, 2005

Problem Description:

Soil and groundwater beneath the site are contaminated by petroleum hydrocarbons related to the former retail gasoline station at 900 Santa Rosa Avenue. Contaminants include gasoline, diesel and motor oil range hydrocarbons.

Site Characterization:

Numerous soil borings have been drilled and ground water monitoring wells have been installed. The presence of separate phase hydrocarbons was discovered in soil borings drilled north of the site in Bennett Valley Road. A dissolved plume extends off site to the southwest.

Proposed Corrective Action:

The responsible party proposed a combination of alternatives including the excavation of impacted soil and dewatering from the open excavation. Ozone sparging and oxygen injection to enhance bioremediation is proposed to address groundwater impacts that remain after the excavation and dewatering work is completed.
