Notice of Proposed Corrective Action

Rotten Robbie Service Station #40
2515 Guerneville Road
Santa Rosa, CA
Case No. 1TSR022

Problem Description:

A Rotten Robbie retail gasoline station occupies property at 2515 Guerneville Road in Santa Rosa. Discharges of petroleum hydrocarbons have occurred from the underground storage tank system to soil and groundwater. Soil and groundwater contaminants include gasoline and gasoline constituents (benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylenes, MtBE and TBA).

Site Characterization:

The extent of contamination has been defined via the drilling of soil borings and the installation of groundwater monitoring wells. Groundwater impacts are present beneath the site with offsite impacts to the south, in the down gradient groundwater flow direction beneath Guerneville Road.

Proposed Corrective Action:

Interim remediation was conducted in May 2006 and included the removal of impacted soil to the extent practicable. The responsible party proposes to perate an ozone sparge system to address the groundwater impacts.

North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board staff will permit the injection of ozone: 1) upon Mission Trail Oil Company's submittal of a complete and acceptable Notice of Intent for Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2006-0107, and 2) the absence of significant public comment regarding the proposed corrective action.
