Proposed Actions:

- Valero Marketing and Supply Company (Valero) submitted a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) proposal to clean up petroleum releases at the former Texaco service station at 1400 Farmers Lane in Santa Rosa. The CAP specifies a plan for injecting chemical amendments into groundwater beneath the site to enhance the in-situ biological degradation of petroleum related compounds.
- Valero submitted a Notice of Intent to apply for regulatory coverage for the proposed remedial activities under the provisions of *General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. R1-2004-0021 for In Situ Bioremediation of Petroleum Hydrocarbons by the Addition of Nutrients, Microorganisms, and/or an Oxygen Source to Groundwater and/or Soil* (Order).

On the basis of preliminary review and application of lawful standards and regulations, the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff intends to concur with implementing the proposed CAP and with extending coverage for the proposed groundwater remediation project under the provisions of the Order unless significant information or objections are submitted before the end of comment period identified above.
