**NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF COVERAGE UNDER
GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER NO. R1-2006-0107**

SONOMA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), North Coast Region, proposes to extend coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2006-0107 (Order) for Graton Fire Protection District at 3160 Ross Rd, Graton, California (Site). A release from underground petroleum storage tanks located at the site discharged petroleum hydrocarbons and associated chemicals to the subsurface that have impacted groundwater. As part of the approved remedial action plan, the discharger has installed an ozone injection system to clean up petroleum hydrocarbons in the soil and groundwater at the Site. On November 29, 2006, the Regional Water Board adopted General Order No. R1-2006-0107 for the addition of chemical oxidants to soils and/or groundwater. Therefore, all sites with ozone injection systems must be covered under Order No. R1-2006-0107 in order to operate.

The discharger and/or other interested persons may call Beth Lamb at (707) 576-2669 or submit to the Regional Board office at 5550 Skylane Boulevard, Suite A, Santa Rosa, CA 95403, written comments, technical reports, testimony, and other evidentiary material concerning this matter by 5:00 p.m., up to 30 days from the date of this publication.

Coverage under WDR Order No. R1-2006-0107 will be granted after thirty days from the date of the publication and posting of this notice, unless the Executive Officer receives information that the project may not meet the intent of the Order.
