North Coast Region Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) is considering extending regulatory coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2006-0107 (Order) for subsurface chemical injections at 1320 Airport Road in Ukiah. The City of Ukiah has submitted a proposal to inject ozone into soil and groundwater beneath the site to cleanup impacts from petroleum discharges and a Notice of Intent (NOI) to comply with the Order in implementing the project. Regional Water Board staff reviewed the NOI and determined that the project is eligible for coverage under the provisions of the Order.

Ozone is a chemical oxidant that has been used at many cleanup sites to destroy petroleum contamination in soil and in groundwater. Under the provisions of the Order, a groundwater and soil vapor monitoring program will be implemented to ensure that chemicals associated with the cleanup activities will not adversely impact water quality or migrate from the site. The project is intended to reduce petroleum concentrations to levels that achieve water quality objectives for the protection of water supply sources.

Coverage under the Order will be extended for the project following the above-posted end of the comment period unless significant information is submitted indicating the project may not meet the intent of the Order. Documents related to the site investigation are contained in the case file identified as the *Ukiah Corporation Yard*, Case Number 1TMC201 and may be inspected or copied at the Regional Water Board office.
