This notice invites the public to review and comment on the consideration of no further action for the military cleanup case No. 1DODNHU843 in Trinidad, California (site). The case will be closed at the end of the comment period unless new and significant information is submitted indicating that further actions are necessary.

Problem Description

From 1944 to 1946, the Department of Defense (DoD) used the site as a dive bombing and aerial gunnery range.

Actions Completed

Site reconnaissance was performed on July 20, 2006, to identify evidence of environmental impacts from DoD activities.

Water Quality Assessment

No obvious or direct evidence of contamination was observed at the site.
