The California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), North Coast Region, proposes to extend coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2000-51 (Order) for the former Redwood Oil Service Station, 235 South Cloverdale Boulevard, Cloverdale, California (Site). A release from the former underground gasoline storage tanks discharged petroleum hydrocarbons and associated chemicals to the subsurface that have impacted groundwater. As part of the approved workplan, the discharger proposes to excavate approximately 250 cubic yards of soil, and place oxygen releasing compounds (ORC) into the excavation prior to backfilling.

On July 27, 2000, the Regional Water Board adopted General Order No. R1-2000-51 for the addition oxygen releasing compounds (ORC) to groundwater. Therefore, all sites using ORC products must be covered under Order No. R1-2000-51.
