The California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), North Coast Region, proposes to extend coverage for *In Situ Soil and Groundwater Remediation for Volatile Organic Compounds and/or Metal Impacted Sites Within the North Coast Region* to remediate volatile organic compounds in groundwater at the above named site under General Waste Discharge Requirements (GWDR) Order No. R1-2009-0105. This remedial technique has been proposed as a corrective action to cleanup groundwater contaminated by releases associated with discharges to groundwater in the area of E and Grotto Streets in Eureka, California (Case No. 1NHU983).
