The California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), North Coast Region, proposes to extend coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2006-0107 (Order) for the Colbert Property, 19290 South Harbor Drive, Fort Bragg California (Site). The Regional Water Board adopted General Order No. R1-2006-0107 for the addition of chemical oxidants to soils and/or groundwater on November 29, 2006.

A release from underground petroleum storage tanks formerly located at the Site discharged petroleum hydrocarbons and associated chemicals to the subsurface that have impacted groundwater. A 90-day pilot test to determine if ozone injection will be effective in the cleanup of residual petroleum hydrocarbons in the soil and groundwater has been proposed at the Site. Depending on the results of the pilot test, additional ozone injection might be performed.
