The California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), North Coast Region, proposes to extend coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2006-0107 (Order) for the Turner's Automotive, 9001 Graton Road, Graton, California (Site). The Regional Water Board adopted General Order No. R1-2006-0107 for the addition of chemical oxidants to soils and/or groundwater on November 29, 2006 (revised on June 12, 2008). The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, of this proposed remediation and to invite public comment.

A release from underground petroleum storage tanks at the Site discharged petroleum hydrocarbons and associated chemicals to the subsurface that have impacted groundwater. A pilot test to determine if ozone or hydrogen peroxide injection will be effective in the cleanup of residual petroleum hydrocarbons in the soil and groundwater has been proposed at the Site. Depending on the results of the pilot test, additional ozone and/or hydrogen peroxide injection might be performed.
