The Willits Environmental Remediation Trust (WERT) is proposing to inject reducing agents in accordance with Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2009-0001 for In-Situ Groundwater Treatment at the former Remco Hydraulics Facility located at 934 South Main Street in Willits, California.

The WERT is proposing to inject treatment solutions to reduce volatile organic compounds contamination. A description of the reinjection and groundwater monitoring program is contained in a work plan titled: "Fifth Work Plan Addendum for In-Situ Treatment of VOCs in Shallow Groundwater" for the Former Remco Hydraulics Facility, dated February 5, 2016.
