GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

FOR Addition of Chemical Oxidants to Soil and Groundwater

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (RWQCB) has received a Notice of Intent for the addition of chemical oxidants (ozone and hydrogen peroxide) at the above named site (RWQCB Case No. 1NHU655) under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2006-0107 (Order NO. 0107). The purpose of this notice is to solicit public comment on this Notice of Intent.

Ozone and hydrogen peroxide will be injected into the subsurface for a period of ten days to oxidize residual pentachlorophenol (PCP) and tetrachlorophenol (TCP) impact to soil associated with former wood preserving activities at the above named site. This corrective action has been proposed to reduce PCP and TCP concentrations in groundwater at the site toward water quality objectives of 1.0 micrograms per liter.

The public comment period will be completed no more than 30 days from the issuance of this notice. The related documents and comments received are on file and may be inspected or copied at the Regional Water Board office, 5550 Skylane Boulevard, Suite A, Santa Rosa, California.
