NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT WITH
COAST WOOD PRESERVING, INC.

FOR VIOLATIONS ALLEGED IN
COMPLAINT NO. R1-2009-0118

WRITTEN COMMENTS DUE NO LATER THAN
5:00 P.M., on February 5, 2010

On November 23, 2009, the Discharger and the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Board) Prosecution Team entered into a tentative settlement to resolve the violations for the failure to timely submit Annual Storm Water Reports for fiscal years 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 alleged in Administrative Civil Liability Complaint No. R1-2009-0118 (Complaint) issued to Coast Wood Preserving, Inc., (Discharger). Per the terms of settlement set forth in the Waiver Form, the Discharger waived the right to a hearing before the Regional Board and submitted a payment in the amount of \$4,430. Due to the tentative settlement, this matter has been removed from the January 21, 2010 Board Meeting Agenda. Persons may comment on the proposed settlement by submitting written comments so that they are received **no later than 5:00 p.m. on February 5, 2010**. Written comments should include "ACL Complaint No. R1-2009-0118" in the subject line, and should be submitted to the attention of Manuel Baldenegro at 5550 Skylane Blvd., Suite A, Santa Rosa, CA 95403 or submitted via e-mail to mbaldenegro@waterboards.ca.gov. Should the Regional Water Board receive significant new information or comments from any source (excluding the Water Board's Prosecution Team) during this comment period, the Regional Water Board's Assistant Executive Officer may withdraw the Complaint, return payment, and issue a new complaint. If no significant new information or comments are received, this tentative settlement shall become final on February 6, 2010.
