On May 28, 2014, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Board) posted the signed Settlement Agreement and Stipulation for entry of Administrative Civil Liability Order, No. R1-2014-0032 (Order) from the Crescent City Harbor District. The Order describes a proposed settlement with the Crescent City Harbor District (Discharger) to resolve violations subject to mandatory minimum penalties alleged in Complaint No. R1-2011-0077. The Complaint proposed that the Regional Water Board assess mandatory minimum penalties in the amount of \$123,000 for violations of effluent limits. Public comment will be received pursuant to the California Water and Government Codes commencing on May 28, 2014 until June 27, 2014, and can be submitted by email at northcoast@waterboards.ca.gov Attn. Nancy Robinson. After the public comment period, the Stipulated Order is expected to be signed by the Executive Officer and become a final Order.
