The California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), North Coast Region, proposes to concur with the Final Remedial Action Plan for the former Ecodyne Site at 930 Shiloh Road, in Windsor, CA. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

Ecodyne Corporation manufactured evaporative cooling towers at this property. Lumber used in the towers were treated on site to minimize decay. Ecodyne operated as a wood treatment facility from 1965 to 1984. A chromate copper arsenate was used as a wood preservative. Elevated levels of chromium were first discovered at the Site in 1982. Remediation of the property started in 1983 and included removal of buildings and subsurface structures, installation of an asphalt cap, electrochemical treatment of extracted groundwater and in-situ treatment of soil and groundwater. Remediation efforts have reduced the concentrations of hexavalent chromium in soil and groundwater. However, concentrations of hexavalent chromium persist above water quality objectives in groundwater in a limited area of the Site.

The proposed final remedy includes a land use covenant and long term monitoring of storm water and groundwater.
