A soil and groundwater investigation and remediation was conducted at the above-referenced site and a release of petroleum hydrocarbons was documented. Regional Water Board staff proposes that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

Problem Description

An unauthorized discharge of petroleum hydrocarbons was discovered during the removal of an underground storage tank. Subsurface investigation was conducted to define the extent of contamination in soil and groundwater. Findings from the investigation led to over-excavation of contaminated soil to the extent practical. Some soil contamination remains. No water supply wells are impacted or threatened by the contamination, and no exposure pathways were identified that could affect human health or the environment.

Proposed Action

A "no further action" determination related to the discharge of petroleum hydrocarbons is proposed.

Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with the "no further action" determination upon conclusion of the comment period.
