Proposed Action:

This notice invites the public to comment on the proposed decision to require no further action for the investigation and cleanup of volatile organic compound releases at the Pacific Gas & Electric Santa Rosa Service Center site, located at 3965 Occidental Road, Santa Rosa. Regional Water Board staff proposes to close the site investigation case following a period for public review and comment on the decision.

Problem Description: In 1987, soil and groundwater samples collected during the removal of three underground tanks (USTs) revealed petroleum product and waste oil releases to the adjacent soil and groundwater. Solvents were released as part of the waste oil discharges.

Remedial Actions Conducted:

- In 1987, three USTs and the adjacent soil were excavated for off-site disposal.
- Groundwater extraction and treatment was conducted from 1992 to 2000.
- Groundwater, soil vapor and air monitoring has defined the extent of contamination.

Site Assessment: The sources of contamination have been removed to the extent feasible. Groundwater contamination is limited to the immediate vicinity of the site. No water supply wells or surface water bodies are impacted or threatened. A land use covenant will prevent potential future exposures to contamination remaining in groundwater at the site. Unless significant comments or new information is presented, Regional Water Board staff will proceed with the case closure process upon conclusion of the comment period.
