## **Notice of Proposed No Further Action**

A soil and groundwater investigation conducted at the referenced site discovered a release of petroleum hydrocarbons in the gasoline range (TPHg). Although some contamination remains, this site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's Resolution 92-49. Regional Water Board staff proposes that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

## **Problem Description**

The Regional Water Board was first alerted of a reported small gasoline spill (150-240 gallons) from an above ground storage tank (AST) at the site in March of 2014. During the soil excavation around the AST and connective piping, two abandoned underground storage tanks (USTs) were discovered downgradient of the AST. These USTs had significant evidence of leaking. The discovery of the abandoned USTs and respective subsurface impacts prompted the opening of UST Case No. 1NMC630, which is being investigated separately. Groundwater monitoring at the site has shown contamination in groundwater in the immediate vicinity of the AST, but the contamination is no longer spreading and any remaining impacts from the AST do not pose a threat to human health or the environment.

## **Proposed Action**

Case closure is proposed. This site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's "Resolution 92-49"
