The North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) Executive Officer is proposing to issue a Time Schedule Order for the City of Santa Rosa Wastewater Reclamation Facility. Staff of the Regional Water Board have prepared a tentative Order for this discharger extending by one year the commencement of the timeframe for determining compliance described in Attachment 1 to Resolution R1-2008-0064 (the Nutrient Offset Program).

The City of Santa Rosa owns a wastewater collection, treatment, reuse and disposal facility with a design average dry weather treatment capacity of 21.34 mgd for treating domestic, commercial, and industrial wastewater. The current discharge permit, Order No. R1-2006-0045, contains limitations on the discharge of nutrients to Santa Rosa Creek and the Laguna de Santa Rosa and the option to develop a Nutrient Offset Program to comply with the nutrient limitations. The Nutrient Offset Program was adopted by the Regional Water Board on July 24, 2008, through Resolution No. R1-2008-0061.

The Regional Water Board Executive Officer intends to consider adopting the tentative Order after reviewing all public comments.

**The deadline for comment is 5:00 p.m. on October 24, 2011.** Comments must be sent to the **attention of Kason Grady**. Persons wishing to file written comments on, or objections to, the tentative Order must do so no later than this deadline in order for staff to have time to consider and respond to such comments. The Water Board will not accept written comments after the deadline noted above. Any person submitting late

comments or other evidence must explain why such materials were not submitted by the deadline.

***Document Review***

The tentative Order, related documents, and comments received by the Regional Water Board will be on file and may be inspected or copied at the Regional Water Board's office, 5550 Skylane Boulevard, Suite A, Santa Rosa, California.
