North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (NCRWQCB)

I live on the South Fork Trinity River and would like to encourage you to support restoring our sediment-impaired watersheds in Northern CA. I am particularly concerned with the South Fork Trinity and all the tributaries to the Klamath. We need a clean Klamath to ring the Salmon home to their spawning rivers. The South Fork Trinity has a very small native salmon run and I would love to see it grow instead of the decline I have observed in the last 30 years since I have been on the SF Trinity.

I support the sediment resolution, and encourage you to do all you can to restore sediment-impaired watersheds. Please work to control timber and agriculture related sediment and decommissioning roads, enforcing water quality standards. Work to identify other waterways in Northern California - such as the upper mid-Klamath - that have sediment problems but are not yet listed as impaired.

Thank you for working on these important issues and helping to bring the salmon home.
