**NORTH COAST REGIONAL WATER BOARD EXECUTIVE OFFICER WILL
ATTEND HIS LAST BOARD MEETING ON JUNE 28, 2001**

SANTA ROSA – Lee Michlin, Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) in Santa Rosa, will attend his last Board meeting on June 28, 2001, in Santa Rosa. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) and the nine Regional Boards are responsible for protecting the beneficial uses of the state’s water resources.

Michlin is stepping down to pursue other interests after heading the Regional Board staff for more than three years. During his tenure, Michlin managed many difficult and controversial issues, including the adoption of the Garcia River Total Maximum Daily Load, a water quality protection/improvement tool required by the federal Clean Water Act. Under Michlin’s direction, staff at the Regional Board has increased 115 percent.
