Water board staff will evaluate the application prior to approval. A \$200 administrative fee is required unless you qualify for an exemption described in the first two check boxes below.

- The property was purchased after 31 December 2006 (attach a copy of the deed and do not submit an administrative fee).

Box 1. PARCEL INFORMATION: List all parcels currently owned or owned within the previous 5 years by the addressee, (disclosing all parcels will help prevent future mailings from the Water Board). Indicate if the parcel has an agricultural operation, is irrigated, and if the parcel has the potential to discharge waste (see definition of discharge below). Staff will contact the landowner prior to any inspection that requires entering private property.

- i) Commercial agricultural operation means any property that is used to sell a commodity, whether an actual profit is made or not.
- ii) The definition of irrigated lands includes “lands where water is applied to produce crops, including, but not limited to, land planted to row, vineyard, pasture, field and tree crops, commercial nurseries, nursery stock production, managed wetlands, rice production, and greenhouse operations with permeable floors that do not currently discharge under waste discharge requirements, National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits, Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System permits, or other NPDES permits.”
- iii) Discharges of Waste from irrigated lands includes irrigation return flows, subsurface drainage (e.g., tile drains, deep drainage ditches, or wells), stormwater leaving property anytime during the year, and operational spills and could have the potential to discharge waste that could directly or indirectly reach surface waters of the State.

Box 2. REGULATORY COVERAGE FOR IRRIGATED LANDS:

If you own/operate irrigated agriculture with the potential to discharge waste then regulatory coverage is required. Select a regulatory option in Box 2(a) through Box 2(c) or indicate why the land does not need regulatory coverage in Box 2(d).

- a) If the property was not in production or was purchased after 31 December 2006, then an administrative fee is not required. If the properties were irrigated agriculture with the potential to discharge and did not meet a condition mentioned, then a **\$200 administrative fee** (made payable to the State Water Resources Control Board) is due with the technical report. Pursuant to State Board Resolution 2008-0073 this fee was developed to cover the Central Valley Water Board’s cost of conducting non-participant outreach.
- b) Review the documents associated with filing as an Individual on the Central Valley Water Board website and complete the “Notice of Intent for Individual Dischargers.”
- c) Review the documents associated with filing a Report of Waste discharge on the Central Valley Water Board website. Download the application, “Form 200 for filing a Report of Waste Discharge for Waste Discharge Requirements” at: <http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sbforms/form200.pdf>
- d) Select the condition that applies as to why the Addressee does not need regulatory coverage. Selections include ‘Already Enrolled in a Coalition Group’, ‘Covered under the Dairy Order’, ‘Have Filed a Report of Waste Discharge’, ‘Does not own’, ‘No runoff’, or ‘Other.’ Additional directions for select conditions are provided below:
 - i) Already a Member of a Coalition Group, please attach proof of current enrollment.
 - ii) If your parcels are covered under a Dairy Order, please provide the site address (in Box 3) of the dairy covered by the Order, as it appears in the Order (for individual orders) or Existing Conditions Report.
 - iii) Please include your WDR number and date filed; or if currently filing please review the documents associated with filing a Report of Waste discharge on the Central Valley Water Board website. Download the application, “Form 200 for filing a Report of Waste Discharge for Waste Discharge Requirements” at: <http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sbforms/form200.pdf>
 - iv) Other: Please provide the appropriate information in Box 3.
