Here is the Final Agenda for tomorrow's meeting. I revised the following items from the draft agenda that I sent to you on 18 April 2011:

- **Responses to the 26 April 2010 Grower Notification** for CURES-AWEP funding. This notification was sent to 429 members of the 1st and 2nd set of High Priority areas. The same letter was sent again on 10/8/11? If so, why? No response from growers on the first batch? (2011 Annual MPUR pages 44-46). The responses from Duck Slough at Hwy 99 growers indicated that the recommended management practices were not implemented due to lack of resources.

- **Percentage of implemented management practices at the 1st set of High Priority areas.** The percentage of implemented management practices at Dry Creek at Wellsford and Prairie Flower are 455% and 136%. Could you please, briefly, explain this at the meeting?
