Re: ESJWQC Management Plan Performance Goal Schedule Update for 3<sup>rd</sup> Priority Subwatersheds

Dear Ms. Fregien,

As indicated in a letter mailed to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board on June 30, 2011 the Coalition is submitting a status update on the ESJWQC Management Plan performance goal schedule for third priority subwatersheds.

Since June 30, 2011, the Coalition has meet with an additional 5 growers in Berenda Slough, 4 growers in Dry Creek, and 5 growers in Lateral 2 ½ subwatersheds (total of 14 new visits). As of July 15, the Coalition has visited with and documented management practices from 32 growers (42% of the total number of growers to visit) representing 51% of the targeted acreage across all four priority subwatersheds (Table 1).
