Hi Susan,

We did receive clarification and Levee Drain does NOT receive water from Lower Lateral No 4.

Below is the response from Keith Larson at TID:

"To answer your question, TID does not have the ability to route water from Lower Lateral 4 to the Levee Drain. The two facilities do not have a physical connection and even if they did we would not route the water down the Levee due to the drain's configuration. The water in the Levee Drain at the Carpenter Rd. monitoring site would originate from ag sources with no municipal or residential influence and therefore should be a good representative site for the Coalition's monitoring program."
