RE: ESJWQC amendments to the Monitoring and Reporting Program Plan (MRPP), Annual Monitoring Report (AMR) 2012 and Management Plan Update Report (MPUR) 2012.

Dear Ms. Creedon,

The East San Joaquin County Water Quality Coalition (ESJWQC or Coalition) is submitting amendments to the Monitoring and Reporting Program Plan (MRPP) and 2012 Management Plan Update Report (MPUR) for the recent approval to suspend Core Monitoring, reduce Assessment Monitoring and suspend Management Plan Monitoring (MPM) with the exception of Bear Creek @ Kibby Rd for the remainder of 2012 (approved April 17, 2012). Additional amendments to the MRPP have also been made to account for the removal of the Duck Slough @ Hwy 99 sampling location (approved April 26, 2012).

In addition, amendments to the 2012 MPUR have been made to include a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Dissolved Oxygen section. Furthermore, a lab report from April 2011 was recently revised and detections that were reported in error have been amended in both the 2012 AMR, 2012 MPUR. The SWAMP comparable Access database with updated data from the revised lab report will be submitted with the June 1, 2012 quarterly data submittal. The amendments described above collectively include:

- I. Revisions for reduced monitoring approval
 - a. ESJWQC MRPP (Tables A, 8, 9, 10 and 12)
 - b. ESJWQC 2012 MPUR (Tables B and 7)
 - c. ESJWQC 2012 Monitoring Schedule (excel file as advised by staff-phone call on April 18, 2012)
- II. Amendments for revised April 2011 pesticide lab report to exclude reported detections (demeton-s, dimethoate, phosmet, Atrazine and cyanazine) and an exceedance (azinphos methyl) at Berenda Slough @ Ave 18 ½.
 - a. 2012 AMR (Tables A, 1, 35 and 45, and Appendices II and IV)
 - b. 2012 MPUR (Tables B, 4 and 5, and Appendix I Table VIII-5)
 - c. Revised April 2011 APPL lab report
- III. Amendment to 2012 MPUR to include TMDL Dissolved Oxygen section (Pages 143-144)
- IV. Amendment to MRPP to omit Duck Slough @ Hwy 99 from the ESJWQC monitoring program
 - a. ESJWQC MRPP (Tables A, 4, 5, 7 and 10 and verbiage Page 42)
