>>>> amendment tables (e.g Tables 4 and 5 are labeled 1 and 2, and so on. and  
>>>> the VIII-5 table has an error message). The numbering issue is perhaps due  
>>>> to automatic numbering in each document. The changes are not critical,  
>>>> especially if it is too complicated or if it will take too much time.

>>>> Thank you for submitting the amendments to the ESJWQC MRP Plan, 2012  
>>>> AMR and 2012 MPUR. The addition of Table A to the 2012 AMR, and Table B to  
>>>> the 2012 MPUR was an appropriate way to document which sections and tables  
>>>> were affected by the revised laboratory report for the April 2011 samples  
>>>> from Berenda Slough @ Ave 18 1/2.  
>>>> The following minor issues were identified in the submitted documents:  
>>>>  
>>>> - While the revision of Table 1 in the 2012 AMR was not necessary  
>>>> as the MRP Plan changes occurred after 1 April 1 2012, please note that  
>>>> Item #7 should be included in the future MRPP amendment summaries, along  
>>>> with the removal of the monitoring site Duck Slough @ Hwy 99 (e.g. Item #8  
>>>> in Table 1 of the AMR). No action is needed, the change is to be included  
>>>> in the future AMR's.  
>>>> - In addition to the amended Table VIII-5, verbiage on p. 241 of  
>>>> the MPUR Appendix I should also be adjusted to reflect changes due to the  
>>>> revised APPL results at Berenda Slough @ Ave 18 1/2. Please submit the  
>>>> corrected text.  
>>>> - The cover letter correctly identifies the revised tables by  
>>>> numbers, however some tables are misnumbered in the AMR and MPUR amendment  
>>>> documents.

>>>> Finally, in addition to the monitoring schedule as laid out in the  
>>>> reduced monitoring amendments, please remember the changes in diazinon and  
>>>> chlorpyrifos TMDL compliance monitoring that were outlined in the 27 March  
>>>> 2012 letter from the Central Valley Water Board. The compliance points in  
>>>> the San Joaquin River are to be monitored monthly from May to August 2012.  
>>>> Please do not hesitate to call if you have any questions.
