ORDER NO. 71-37

AMENDING THE TIME SCHEDULE CONTAINED IN  
RESOLUTION NO. 70-73 FOR COMPLIANCE WITH  
THE REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTION NO. 70-52  
BY THE CITY OF PINOLE.

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds:

1. On June 25, 1970, this Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 70-52 to prescribe revised requirements for waste discharge by City of Pinole into San Pablo Bay after considering this matter and the testimony of the discharger and others at a public meeting.
2. This Board amended Resolution No. 70-52 by adopting Resolution No. 70-73, a partial time schedule for compliance with the revised requirements, on September 24, 1970.
3. Resolution No. 70-73 provided that the Regional Board would establish dates for completing construction of the necessary facilities, and for demonstrating compliance with the requirements of Resolution No. 70-52 after comparing bids for alternate construction periods of 8, 10, and 12 months.
4. The discharger has requested the Regional Board to modify the compliance time schedule of Resolution No. 70-73 to provide for facilities to be operational and meet requirements 12 months after award of a contract scheduled for August 3, 1971.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The time schedule of Resolution No. 70-73 is amended in part to read:

Review bids and award contract	August 3, 1971	August 18, 1971

Demonstrate compliance with all the requirements of Resolution No. 70-52	August 3, 1972	August 18, 1972.
