ORDER NO. 72-46

RESCINDING ORDER NO. 71-21
FOR
STAUFFER CHEMICAL COMPANY
MARTINEZ PLANT
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

- A. On April 22, 1971, Order No. 71-21, an Order to Cease and Desist violations of the requirements of Resolution No. 68-68 was issued to the Stauffer Chemical Company Plant at Martinez.
- B. Stauffer Chemical Company has made process changes, installed pH neutralizing and control equipment, and has eliminated sludge acid sewer drains from their treatment ponds.
- C. Stauffer Chemical Company is in compliance with the discharge requirements specified in the cease and desist order and has complied with the provisions of that order.
- D. The Board at a public meeting on July 25, 1972, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

This Board's Order No. 71-21 is rescinded.
