ORDER NO. 72-58

RESCINDING ORDER NO. 70-3 and RESOLUTION NO. 68-39
HERCULES, INC.
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region finds that:

- A. On March 14, 1970, Order No. 70-3, an order to Cease and Desist from discharging wastes contrary to requirements prescribed in Resolution No. 68-39 was issued to Hercules, Inc. by the State Water Resources Control Board.
- B. On October 22, 1970, Resolution No. 70-77 was adopted, prescribing revised discharge requirements and amending Resolution No. 68-39.
- C. Hercules, Inc. as of May 15, 1971, completed the last phase in the installation of: (1) oxidation and settling pond, (2) chlorination facilities, (3) pH control system, and (4) wastewater collection system. The methanol, resin, and Nitroform fertilizer production processes have been terminated.
- D. The section of Resolution No. 70-77 entitled "Notifications, Paragraph 3." provides for amending or rescinding Resolution No. 68-39 upon the discharger's demonstration of compliance with all the waste discharge requirements prescribed therein, pursuant to the schedule contained in the State Water Resources Control Board's Order No. 70-3.
- E. Hercules, Inc. is in compliance with the discharge requirements specified in the Cease and Desist Order No. 70-3 and has complied with the provisions of that order.
- F. This Board at a public meeting on August 22, 1972, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The State Board's Order No. 70-3 and the Regional Board's Resolution No. 68-39 are rescinded.
