ORDER NO. 72-59

RESCINDING ORDER NO. 71-10
SEQUOIA REFINING CORPORATION
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

- A. On February 25, 1971, Order No. 71-10, an Order to Cease and Desist from discharging wastes contrary to requirements prescribed in Resolution No. 776 was issued to the Sequoia Refining Corporation.
- B. Sequoia Refining Corporation as of February 3, 1972, completed the last phase in the installation of: (1) ammonia stripping tower, (2) chemical flocculation and dissolved air flotation facilities, (3) pH control facilities and (4) a modified crude oil desalting process.
- C. Sequoia Refining Corporation is in compliance with the discharge requirements specified in the Cease and Desist Order and has complied with the provisions of that order.
- D. This Board at a public meeting on August 22, 1972, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This Board's Order No. 71-10 is rescinded.
