ORDER NO. 72- 65

TECHNICAL REPORTS REQUIRED  
BY  
WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR OCEAN WATERS OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the State Water Resources Control Board did on July 6, 1972, by Resolution No. 72-45, adopt the "WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR OCEAN WATERS OF CALIFORNIA" (hereafter referred to as the Plan) and,

WHEREAS, the Plan, in part, promulgates certain water quality objectives and effluent quality requirements governing the disposal of waste into the coastal waters of California; and

WHEREAS, the Plan directs this Regional Water Quality Control Board to implement said Plan, and further directs that persons responsible for existing waste discharges to ocean waters shall be required by this Regional Board to submit certain technical reports,

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to said Plan and Water Code Section 13267(a) and (b), IT IS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. All persons responsible for existing waste discharges to the ocean in this Region shall not later than January 15, 1973, submit to this Board the technical report required by Chapter VI, Part C of said Plan.
2. Such technical reports shall include at least the information required by Chapter VI, Part C of the Plan, together with such other information and/or analysis as may be required by the Executive Officer of this Board.
3. The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to:
  - (a) Forthwith deliver or cause to be delivered to each person responsible for a waste discharge to the ocean in this Region a copy of this Order, a copy of said Plan, and requests for such other information as he may deem necessary to permit establishment of waste discharge requirements complying with the Plan. Such specifications may be amended, from time to time, as may be deemed necessary by the Executive Officer.
  - (b) Notify all such persons that a failure or refusal to furnish such technical reports, or the falsification of any information therein, is a misdemeanor as provided in Water Code Section 13268. In the event that any such person shall fail or refuse to furnish such report, or falsify the same, the Executive Officer is authorized and directed to take such steps as he deems advisable toward prosecution under Water Code Section 13268.

- (c) Submit to the State Water Resources Control Board prior to April 15, 1973, the technical reports, proposed waste discharge requirements and time schedules required under the Plan.
