ORDER NO. 72-68

WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
FOR  
JAMES IELMORINI DAIRY FARM  
ONTO LAND AT 2665 OLD ADOBE ROAD,  
PETALUMA, CALIFORNIA

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

- A. James Ielmorini, called the discharger below, owns and operates the Ielmorini Dairy Farm at 2665 Old Adobe Road, Petaluma.
- B. Wastes from this dairy farm can enter Washington Creek. Washington Creek flows into the East Washington Street Flood Control Channel which in turn flows into the Petaluma River.
- C. The Board adopted the Interim Water Quality Control Plan for the San Francisco Bay Basin on June 14, 1971.
- D. The beneficial uses of Washington Creek, East Washington Street Flood Control Channel and the Petaluma River include:
  - Swimming, water-skiing, wading, pleasure boating, marinas and fishing.
  - Fish, shellfish and wildlife propagation and sustenance, and waterfowl and migratory bird habitat and resting
  - Navigation channels and port facilities
  - Esthetic enjoyment
- E. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to prescribe waste discharge requirements for the discharge.
- F. The Board at a public meeting on September 26, 1972, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharge.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the discharger shall comply with the following:

A. Waste Discharge Specifications

1. The disposal of waste shall not create a nuisance as defined in Section 13050(m) of the California Water Code.
2. The waste discharge shall be effectively confined to the discharger's property at all times.
3. No waste shall be allowed to enter Washington Creek at any point.
4. The disposal of waste shall not cause degradation of ground water suitable for domestic use.

B. Provisions

1. This Order includes items numbered 1 and 6 of the attached "Reporting Requirements" dated August 28, 1970.
2. This Order includes items numbered 1, 2, 3 and 5 of the attached "Notifications" dated January 6, 1970.

C. Time Schedule

The discharger shall comply with the specifications in this order by October 1, 1972.
