ORDER No. 72-75

RESCINDING ORDER NO. 71-51
UNION OIL COMPANY
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

- A. On July 22, 1971, Order No. 71-51, an Order to Cease and Desist from discharging wastes contrary to requirements prescribed in Resolution No. 68-27 was issued to the Union Oil Company.
- B. The Union Oil Company as of March 30, 1972, completed installation of its dissolved air flotation facility and ballast handling facilities. The Company's report on source stream characterization study of toxicants has been filed with this Board and steps have been taken to eliminate certain of the more toxic streams. The company has indicated that those steps will allow continued compliance with toxicity requirement.
- C. Union Oil Company is in compliance with the discharge requirements specified in the Cease and Desist Order and has complied with the provisions of that order.
- D. This Board at a public meeting on September 26, 1972 heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This Board's Order No. 71-51 is rescinded.
